
Sir,

I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of Government Memo No. 699-A/4c-12a/97(pt), dated 30.04.2015 issued by the Director of Public Instruction, Govt. of West Bengal approving the proposal for establishment of a new Govt. General Degree College in the name and style as "Govt. General Degree College, Ranibandh", P.O. Ranibandh, Dist. Bankura and on the basis of the recommendation made by the Inspection Team, the Vice-Chancellor has been pleased to grant provisional affiliation to the said College for a period of one year to conduct Three Year Degree Honours & General Courses in Arts with the subjects, viz - (i) Bengali (Hons), (ii) English (Hons), (iii) Sanskrit (Hons), (iv) History(Hons), (v) Santhali (Hons) and (vi) Education (Hons), along with combination General subjects such as Bengali, English, Sanskrit, Santhali, History and Education respectively with effect from the Academic Session 2015-2016.

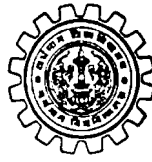
The College Authority should fulfill the following terms and conditions:

1. The College building should be completed in all respects within a year.
2. Library books should be purchased in sufficient number to meet the requirements of the students.
3. The intake capacity will be restricted to 25 students in each Honours subject and 40 students in each General Subject.
4. The admission of students shall be made strictly on the basis of merit following the guidelines of the University.
5. Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff should be appointed as per norms stipulated by the State Government and The University of Burdwan.
6. The Governing Body of the College will be constituted at the earliest as per St. 3(GB) of the Burdwan University Statutes relating to the Constitution, Powers and Functions of the Governing Body of affiliated Colleges other than Government Colleges. Pending that, the College will be run by an Ad-hoc GB duly approved by the University.
7. The fees structure shall be as per norms of the University and Government of West Bengal.
8. The Authority of the College shall abide by the Act, Statutes, Ordinances, Rules & Regulations, etc of the University of Burdwan as are in force and as may be amended from time to time in connection with affiliation, administration, appointment, academic activities etc. of the affiliated Colleges.
9. The College should be inspected by an Inspection Team of the University of Burdwan within a short period.
