

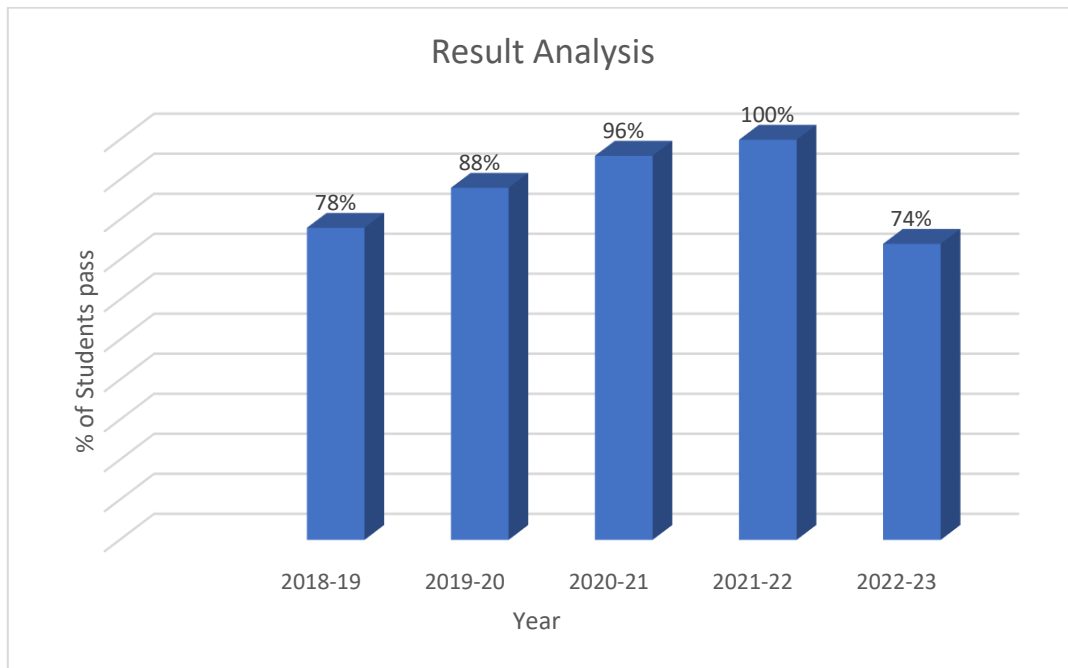

Interpretation of Pass Percentage Trends:

1. **2018-19:**
 - **Pass Percentage:** 78%
 - **Observation:** The pass percentage was relatively modest this year. The number of students who appeared in the final exam was quite low, which could be a factor in this percentage.
2. **2019-20:**
 - **Pass Percentage:** 88%
 - **Observation:** There is a noticeable improvement in the pass percentage compared to the previous year. The number of students increased significantly, which may indicate better preparation or a more effective curriculum.
3. **2020-21:**
 - **Pass Percentage:** 96%
 - **Observation:** The pass percentage saw a remarkable rise, suggesting a high level of academic success. The equal distribution of male and female students who appeared for the exam might reflect well-balanced teaching practices or an improved learning environment.
4. **2021-22:**
 - **Pass Percentage:** 100%
 - **Observation:** This year shows exceptional results with a 100% pass rate. This indicates that all students who appeared for the final exam passed, reflecting a very effective educational approach or a very supportive learning environment.
5. **2022-23:**
 - **Pass Percentage:** 74%
 - **Observation:** There is a decline in the pass percentage compared to the previous year. Despite having a higher number of students appearing for the exam, the lower pass rate suggests potential issues such as changes in teaching methods, curriculum challenges, or student preparedness.

General Trends

- **Increase in Pass Percentage:** From 2018-19 to 2021-22, there was a consistent increase in pass percentages, indicating improvements in educational quality, student performance, or both.
- **Significant Drop:** The decline in 2022-23 after reaching a peak in 2021-22 suggests a need to investigate the reasons behind this drop. Possible factors could include changes in the exam format, variations in student engagement, or external factors impacting student performance.

Detailed Analysis of Decreasing Pass Percentage in 2022-23

Contextual Background

The academic year 2022-23 experienced a significant drop in pass percentage compared to previous years, falling from 100% in 2021-22 to 74%. Several factors likely contributed to this decline, including the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent transitions between online and offline learning environments.

Key Factors Contributing to the Decrease

1. **Transition from Online to Offline Learning and Evaluation:**

The shift from online to offline Examination in 2022-23 might have created adjustment challenges for students. During the pandemic, students adapted to online open book examination system, which may have adverse effect in offline examination.

2. **Drop in Class Attendance:**

The return to offline classes might have been met with reduced class attendance, possibly due to lingering concerns about the pandemic or difficulties in reintegrating into a physical classroom setting.

Lower attendance rates can significantly impact students' learning experiences and outcomes. Missing classes leads to gaps in knowledge and reduced opportunities for engagement with course material and instructors.

3. **Student Preparedness and Adaptation:**

Students might have faced difficulties adapting to offline learning modes, including differences in study habits, classroom interaction, and exam preparation.

- The lack of a smooth transition plan or inadequate support mechanisms for students during this period could have contributed to decreased performance and a lower pass percentage.

Recommendations for Improvement

1. **Enhanced Transition Support:**

Implement targeted support programs to help students adapt to offline learning environments, including orientation sessions and mentoring services.

2. **Improved Attendance Monitoring and Engagement:**

Advice to improve class attendance and student engagement and incentives for regular attendance.

3. **Review and Align Assessment Methods:**

Ensure that assessment methods and evaluation criteria are aligned with current teaching practices and learning environments to provide fair and accurate evaluations of student performance.

4. **Strengthen Educational Resources:**

Increase the availability and accessibility of educational resources, including digital tools and materials, to support students' learning in both online and offline settings.

By addressing these factors and implementing targeted interventions, educational institutions can work towards mitigating the challenges faced in the 2022-23 academic year and improve pass percentages in future academic periods.
